



Hundreds of Thousands of Americans Voice Concern to Biden Administration

Over 13,000 comments came from constituents of Family Policy Alliance and Women's Liberation Front

On Monday, the comment period closed on the Biden Administration's proposed Title IX rule. The rule would force publicly funded schools to allow males to enter female locker rooms and receive scholarships for females. It would also override parental rights and religious liberty concerns, among other concerns.

During the two months the comment period was open, hundreds of thousands of Americans spoke out, many of them in opposition.

Together, constituents of just Family Policy Alliance and Women's Liberation Front (WoLF) submitted 13,108 comments.

In the last week, hundreds of thousands of comments disappeared from the rule's comment portal, reported <u>Politico</u>.

Statement from Autumn Leva, Vice President of Strategy for Family Policy Alliance:

"Real America knows girls deserve their own sports teams and locker rooms, and that parents should be seen as the first line of defense for their children. But in President Biden's America, boys belong on girls' sports teams and in girls' locker rooms, and parents are the enemy to their children and to a radical political agenda. The sheer volume of comments reveals how much this concerns Americans – and we hope the Biden Administration will hear loud and clear."

Statement from Mahri Irvine, Executive Director of Women's Liberation Front:

"Women and girls need single-sex resources, spaces, and sports. The department's proposed Title IX regulations will harm women and girls by placing them at increased risk of sexual violence, domestic violence, and stalking. **These regulations will also eliminate fair athletic competitions for female students, and they will coerce all students and educational employees to comply with gender ideology**, which is nothing more than an anti-science personal belief system based on sex stereotypes."
